

### INT 128 DEGRESSIVE MIRROR

#### INDOOR INSTALLATION



HIDDEN VIEW PARTIALLY

DECREASING POINT SIZE

#### DESCRIPTION

This metallic decreasing film will allow you to maintain your privacy while allowing light to pass through. It will bring you a digressive mirror effect made with points from the smallest to the largest.



**Durability** : 12 to 15 years for a vertical application in Central Europe



**Use** : for all types of glass.



**Maintenance** : after 30 days with a usual cleaning solution (non abrasive, without ammonia...). Cleaning products that could scratch are not recommend.



**Storage** : 2 years from delivery. This film must be stored away from excessive humidity and sunlight, at a temperature below 38°C.

#### Method of application

The surface to be bonded must be free of dust, grease or any other contaminants. Certain materials such as polycarbonate can cause bubbling problems. A compatibility test is therefore recommended. Possibility of placing on plexiglass and polycarbonate.
